Shifter carrier

The carrier holds ratchet mechanism that lets you shift up and down with a toe flick.

34489-52A 1971 Unknown change, probably minor.

34494-72



Some carriers have the 34490-72 casting part number on the "anchor". This one has a square pin like the -52 part. That means this is likely the -72 or -72A version of the part.

34494-72B 1972-1978



Note the round pin and added material so it can be pressed in.



The side that faces the rear of the bike.



34494-74C 1979-1984 Unsure what changes for this part.
