

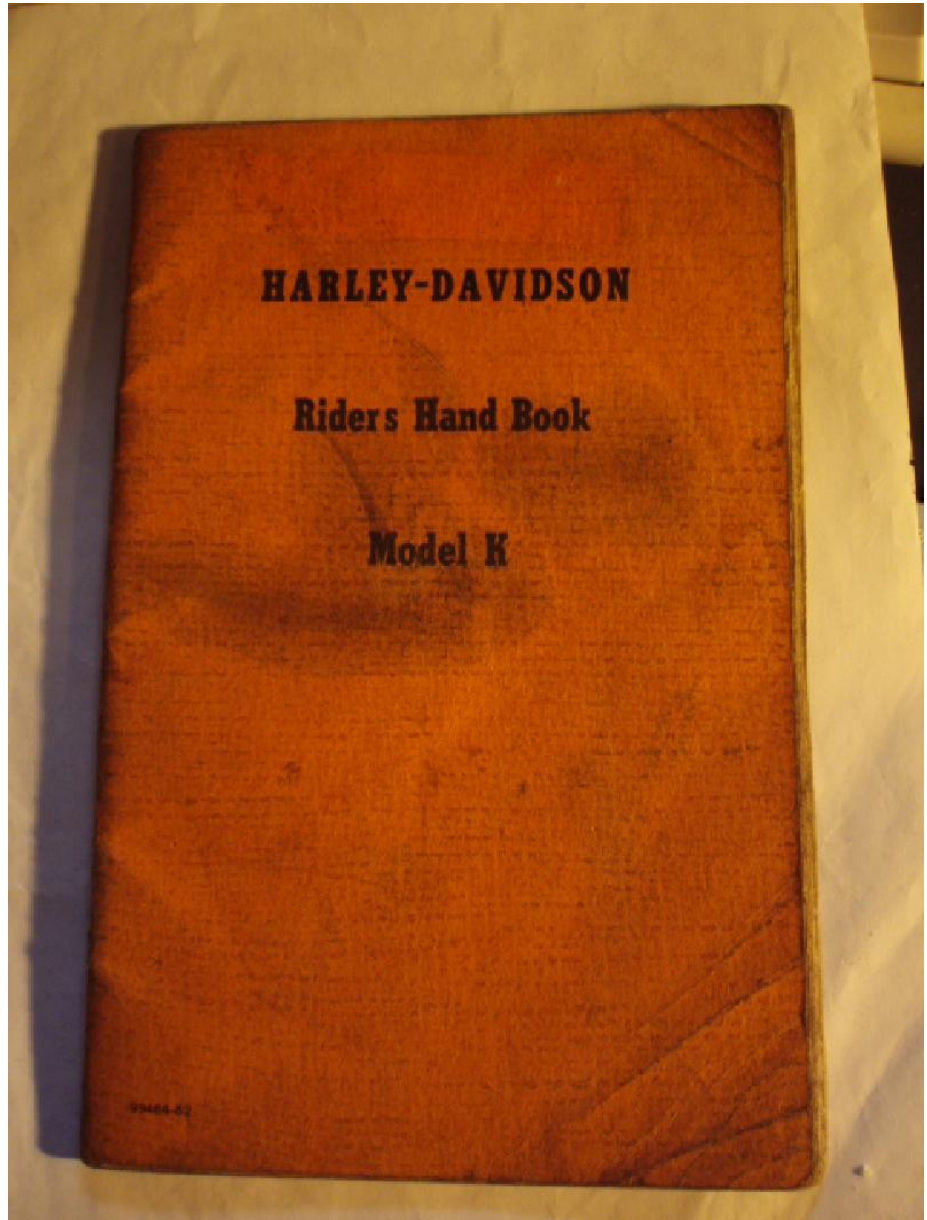
1952 K-model riders hand book

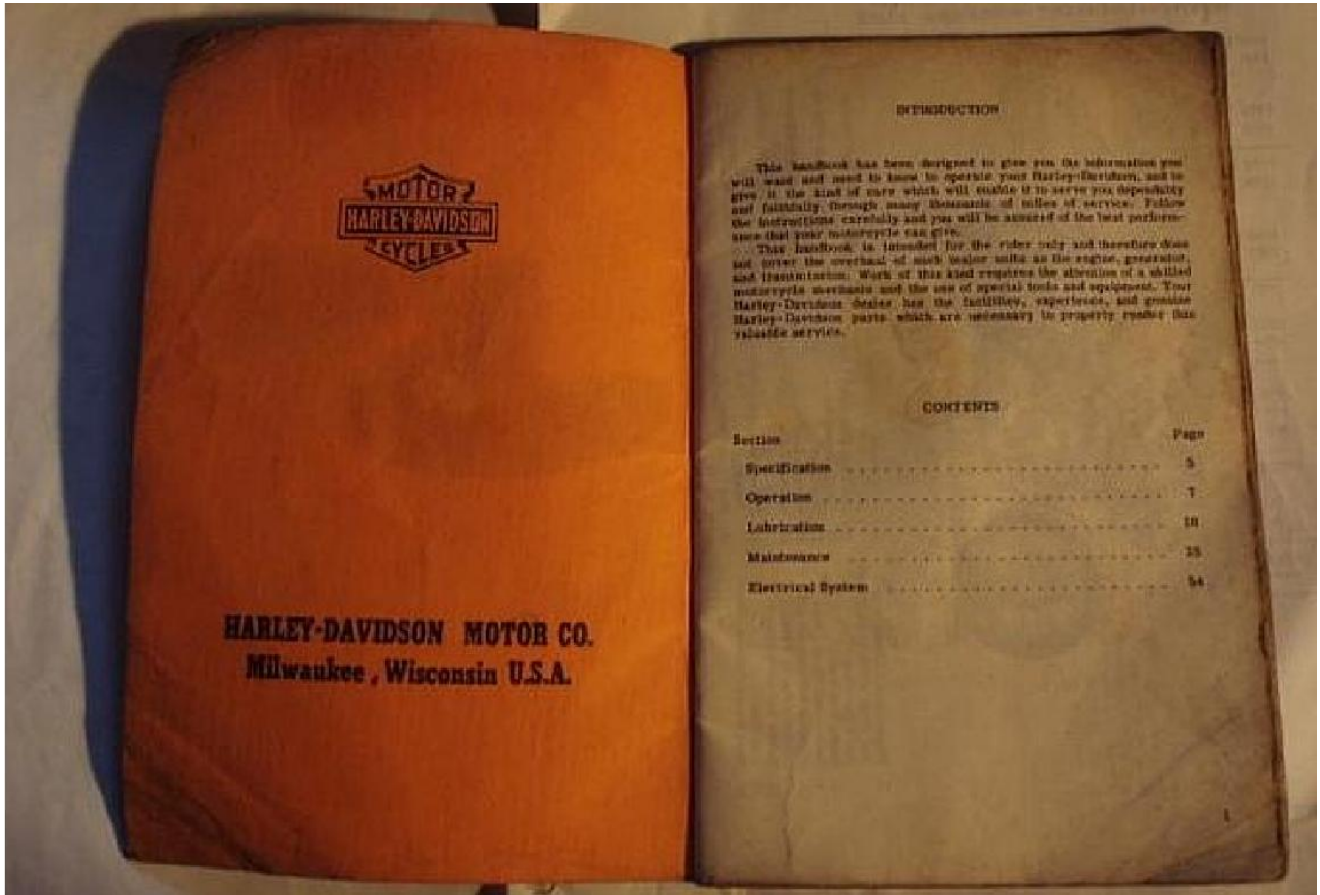
I wanted the real paper book to go with the bike.
